### **Nativity performances**

The Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children will all be starting to practise their Nativity performance after half term.

Here are the times for the performances:

The performances for Nursery/Reception will take place during the school day only and there will be no evening performance.

The performances for Key Stage One will be held over Tuesday 9th December and Wednesday 10th December. To limit the number of people attending in the hall at one time, we have split the dates and times as follows:

Please note that the evening performances for the Year 1 /Year 2 Nativity do require ALL Year 1 and Year 2 children to attend both performances. All of these children are involved in both performances.

There will be a maximum of **2 seats** for each performance.

# Year 1 and Year 2 Performances

Each family (with children in these year groups) have been allocated a maximum of **4 seats** for each performance.

No tickets will be given out. Instead, there will be a list of all of the Foundation Stage and Infant families and names will be crossed out by a member of staff as each family enters the school to take their seats. Please ensure that the correct number of people per family turn up to watch the show to save the embarrassment of having to turn people away.

#### **KS2 Carol Concert**

On the afternoon of **Tuesday 16th December at 2pm**, KS2 will be holding their annual Carol Service in Holy Family Church. All KS2 friends and family are warmly invited to join us.







### Father Christmas visit on Wednesday 17th December

We are excited to welcome Father Christmas into our school on the morning of **Wednesday 17th December**. Your child will get to meet Father Christmas and receive a gift.

Festive Fun Day on Wednesday 17th December. We have a day of Festive Fun activities planned for all of our wonderful children.
