<b>All</b>	<b>Bruno Mars Elton John Zara Larsson</b>	Glittery top/dress or black top Black leggings/trousers/shorts
<b>Year 3</b>	<b>Take That</b>	White vest top, jeans and light (white if possible) trainers.
<b>Year 4</b>	<b>Jackson 5</b>	<b>1970s themed outfit</b> - vibrant colours, bold prints, flares, silk shirt, waistcoat, blazer etc. The children can wear a wig if they wish to.
<b>Year 5</b>	<b>Backstreet Boys</b>	Oversized t-shirts/white t-shirts and an open shirt, jeans and trainers (white if possible). A baseball type cap is optional.
