Please find below information on our after-school club provision for next half-term. Please note that there will be no clubs on the first and last week of this half term. There will be no clubs on Monday 1st of June as this is an INSET day and the school will be closed to children.

REMINDER OF NEW BOOKING PROCESS – BOOKED AND PAID FOR ONLINE!

After school clubs will commence on the week beginning **Monday 8th June**, and will run for 6 weeks. The final session for clubs will be on the week beginning Monday 13th July 2026.

Payment

Please see the below table to find out the cost of each club. Usually, there will be a charge of £4 per session per child, but some external providers do charge more as they include the price of additional equipment or resources. Money is to be paid via School Money/Eduspot. **payment will be made at time of booking now to secure your child's place.**

In the case of a child being absent, we will unfortunately not be able to offer a refund unless there are exceptional circumstances.

Important Note:

Booking process is made online via the School Money/Eduspot App in the same way you would book Wraparound Care – bookings need to be paid to secure your child's place. This will work on first come first served basis until all available places have been filled for that club.

Bookings will go live on Tuesday 2nd June at 6pm to ensure you have had time to discuss at home which clubs you are interested in booking.

Pupil Premium children will be entitled to one free club per half term, please contact the school office to make this booking.
