Y6 Residential 2027- Expression of interest

Monday 23rd March 2026

Dear Parents and Carers of Y5 pupils,

We are excited to propose a fantastic opportunity for our current Year 5 pupils to next year participate in a residential visit to PGL Caythorpe Court in Lincolnshire. As part of this exceptional residential experience, our Year 6 students will have the opportunity to engage in a wide array of exciting outdoor adventurous activities that PGL has to offer, such as climbing, raft building, orienteering, abseiling to name a few.

The date is still to be confirmed but we are looking at May 2027 from a Monday to Friday. We have worked hard to keep the costs as low as possible, and estimate that with a group of 45 children attending, the cost to around £587 per pupil. This price includes all activities, accommodation in en-suite single sex rooms, all meals and beverages at the venue, and transportation to and from PGL. This cost may vary depending on the number attending.

In the same way that the Y5 residential trip to Rootd was organised into monthly payments, we would be organising a similar payment plan for this trip, to help spread the cost into smaller manageable amounts.
