

Year 2 Trip to Florence Nightingale Museum

Dear Parents/ Carers,

As part of our History topic, Year 2 will be going on a trip to **Florence Nightingale Museum on 2 different dates**, the museum can only facilitate 1 class at a time so on:

Thursday 16th April 2026 2L will attend the museum

Friday 17th April 2026 2K will attend the museum.

The children will interact with live actors and immerse themselves in the world of 19th century Britain. They will participate in an immersive session to discover the story of 'The Lady with the Lamp', learn about what happened as a result of her work, followed by self-directed activities in the museum.

We will walk to Northwood station to take a train to Westminster station and then walk to the venue. We ask that your child arrives in full school uniform with a warm/light coat (depending on the weather as it will be summer term) and trainers or comfortable walking shoes. The children will need to bring a snack, packed lunch in a recyclable disposable bag/box and a full water bottle in a small rucksack. If you would like The Pantry to provide a packed lunch on the day, please order a sandwich option online and indicate you have done so on ParentPay.

In order to arrive at the Florence Nightingale Museum in good time for our afternoon session we will leave promptly at 10am, to arrive in Westminster for an early lunch around 11 am with the aim to be ready for our session by 12pm. With this in mind please ensure that your child arrives on time for school. We plan to return to school for 3:15pm the children can have a snack for the train ride home due to the earlier lunch.

We ask parents to give a voluntary contribution of **£10.00**, which includes entrance to the Florence Nightingale Museum. Please pay through ParentPay. Unfortunately, if we are unable to cover the cost of the trip we may need to cancel.

Please confirm your permission for your child to attend the trip on ParentPay. If you are able to assist on the trip and support the children, please also indicate on ParentPay. If we are fortunate enough to be inundated with offers it will be on a first come first serve basis.
