IMPERIAL WAR MUSEUM

On Monday, our Year 6 children had a fantastic day exploring the Imperial War Museum in London. The trip brought their history learning to life as they discovered powerful stories and artefacts from conflicts around the world.

The children visited the World War I and World War II galleries, where they saw real tanks, aircraft, uniforms and personal belongings from soldiers and civilians.
