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I hope you all enjoyed a lovely holiday. It has been wonderful to welcome everyone back to school this week.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you about our uniform expectations. While there is no requirement for items to display the school logo, all clothing—including PE kit—should meet our uniform specifications. We have noticed that some non-uniform items are appearing, such as large logo-branded sportswear, tracksuits in non-uniform colours, and clothing with cartoon characters. We completely understand that in very cold weather you may choose alternative footwear for your child, but at other times children should be wearing their school shoes and trainers on PE days. At the start and end of the school day there is frequently congestion outside school. This is not helped when parents/carers park illegally on double yellow lines or on the white zig zag lines by the zebra crossing. It causes other drivers to become frustrated and creates unnecessary conflict at times. Please park sensibly, safely and lawfully so that the risks of an accident are minimised.

I would also like to remind parents and carers that the staff car park should not be used for routine parking, particularly the marked bays. These bays are designated to ensure that key staff members can park and leave quickly without obstruction during the school day should the need arise — not simply because they are closer to the entrance! If any family needs to use the accessible spaces please pop into the office as we are happy to help.
