MEET THE TEACHER!

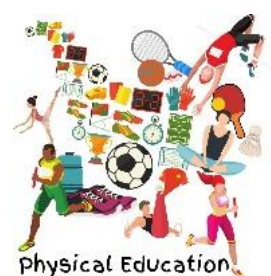
You are invited to meet your child's class teacher at the end of the school day on the following dates.
