FOOTBALL MATCH

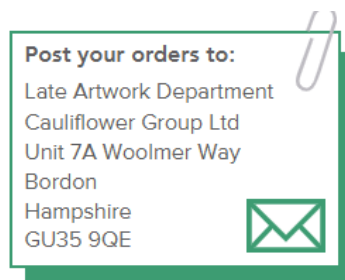
