

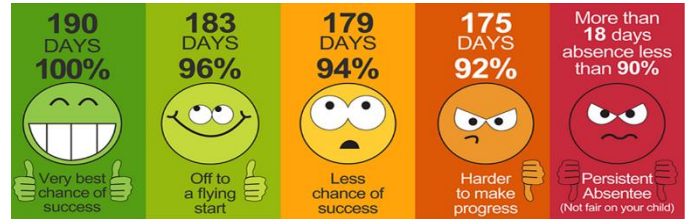

PARKING

We received the email below regarding ongoing parking concerns on Chartwell Road at pick-up time. Please be aware that registration details of vehicles involved have been included on photographs shared with the school of a 2018 registration white Mercedes.

Please can all parents and carers park safely, responsibly, respectfully and legally at all times and be mindful of setting a positive example for the children through considerate behaviour and good citizenship.

Dear Frithwood School and Hillingdon Parking Enforcement,

Further to our previous email, we would like to inform you that the parking situation on Chartwell Road has not improved.

There has been another incident where a white car was seen parking on a driveway while collecting children. As shown in the attached photographs, the situation is extremely concerning. Around 3:00 pm each day, the area becomes particularly chaotic and unsafe.

As previously advised, this creates a serious safety risk, especially for young children who may run towards moving or parked vehicles. We are very worried about the potential for an accident.

We have also found that attempting to speak with parents directly can lead to confrontation, including the use of abusive language. For this reason, we believe the matter requires formal attention and action from the appropriate authorities.

We kindly request that you look into this matter urgently and consider measures to improve safety in the area. Thank you for your attention to this important issue.
