Afterschool Clubs

We have had a great response to our after school sports club, the P1-3 club runs 2-3 and P4-7 3-4 each Tuesday until 6th February. The P1-3 club is full, with a few spaces left for P4-7. Due to the high uptake of club places the Healthy Kidz coach is delivering some free PE sessions. All pupils in P3-7 should come to school on Tuesdays wearing their PE kit. P1&2 should wear their normal uniform as this is suitable for PE.

School Money

Please remember to book your child on for dinner, break and milk each week as this saves staff a lot of time in the mornings. Bookings should be made for the week ahead; we will unbook your child if they are absent. You can make a last minute booking up to midnight the night before.

Outstanding Payments

Please pay any outstanding monies for milk, break, dinners and swimming.

Kitchen Vacancy

We have a vacancy in the school kitchen, washing dishes and serving meals. The hours are Monday to Friday 11am to 1.30pm (12.5 hours per week). No qualifications or experience necessary, training will be provided. Contact Miss Roe or speak to Julie the Cook if interested.

Allergy Aware

Due to children with severe allergies please do not to send nuts or coconut into school. e.g. Nutella. Please note Prime drinks contain coconut water and should not be brought to school.



Car Park

We kindly ask parents, grandparents, childminders etc. NOT to bring their cars into the turning circle either at drop off or pick up time. Please park and walk your child to/from the gate each day.

P7 Swimming

P7 are scheduled to swim this Friday but we anticipate transport may be affected by industrial action. Children should bring rather than wear their swimming things to school.

P7 Transfer

If you have not made an appointment but would like to speak to Miss Roe please contact school.

PE Uniform

Pupils in P3-7 should come to school on PE days wearing their PE kit - a pair of **plain** navy shorts or jogging bottoms, their school polo and sweatshirt and a pair of trainers.

Covid-19

COVID-19 testing is no longer recommended or available for most people but we have some reported cases. If your child has a positive COVID-19 test result, they should stay at home and avoid contact with other people for three days after the day they took the test or from the day their symptoms started (whichever was earliest). After three days, if they feel well and do not have a high temperature, the risk of passing the infection on to others is lower and they should return to school. This is because children and young people tend to be infectious to other people for less time than adults.

Healthy Break

Please remember to send a **healthy** snack for break (no chocolate, crisps or sweeties) or pay for school healthy break - 50p per day for toast and fruit and 10p per day for milk.

Dinners

The cost of school dinners will remain £2.60 per day, this cost is set by the Education Authority. Dinners should also be paid via School Money
