

Mathematics

In maths we will be exploring numbers to 10. Initially counting and making numbers in different ways and then moving onto combining groups to add two numbers together. After that we will move onto taking away small amount to begin subtraction. We will be learning how to set our work out in our new books.

PSHE

We will be learning about 'Being Me in My World'. We will be thinking about being part of a class, feeling special and keeping safe. Also talking about responsibilities.

English

We will be learning about different words that express emotions in our writing using the Colour Monster book as a basis. In our whole class reading we will be reading Little Red Hen and using the VIPERS to explore different aspects of the text, such as inference or sequencing. In guided reading we will be reading text at the appropriate level for our group.

Geography

We will be learning about weather patterns and how they change through different seasons. We'll set up our own weather station and measure temperature and rainfall. We will look at how our position on the globe affects the weather.

Science

We will be learning about the seasons and how nature changes around us. We will be thinking about how animals adapt to cope with the changes. We will learn about migration, hibernation and adaption.

We will be thinking about which books and stories are special to us and to lots of people from a range of religions. We will learn about the Bible, the Qu'ran, the Torah scrolls and more.

We will be learning about the fundamentals of sport and fitness as well as ball skills in our other session.
