- After-school drop-in sessions (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday) until 4:30pm for any children who would like extra support or a quiet place to revise

Alongside the hard work, we are already planning lots of celebrations and memorable experiences for the children to enjoy after SATs. These include events such as our Safari Park trip, Sports Day, the Summer Fayre and our end-of-year activities. We also wanted to give you some advance notice of a few special Year 6 events:
