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UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS



We believe that a consistent school uniform policy is vital to promote the ethos of the school and provide a sense of belonging and identity for all pupils. Our expectations are consistent, fair and inclusive, reflecting the needs of all pupils, and is affordable and the best value for money.

We believe that pupils learn most effectively and achieve their best outcomes when they are comfortable, able to be themselves, and dressed in such a way that sets an appropriate tone for education.

Yellow polo shirt (**with or without the school logo**)
Green jumper/cardigan or fleece (**with the school logo if possible**)
Black or grey trousers/shorts/skirts/dress
Black leather school shoes (**trainers are not allowed on non-PE days**)
Black, white or grey school socks/tights
Yellow or green gingham summer dresses/culottes

PE Uniform

PE days are not non-uniform days. Children in Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6) can come to school in their PE Kit. Children in Key Stage 1 (Year Reception - 2) need to bring their PE Kit to school in a named bag.

Plain white t shirt (**no logos**)
School cardigan/jumper or fleece
Black shorts (**cycling shorts need to be knee length**) OR Black tracksuit bottoms or black leggings (**no large logos**)
Trainers or daps are allowed on PE Days

Normal uniform on the top half
School cardigan/jumper or fleece
Black tracksuit bottoms or black leggings (no large logos)
Children need to bring in wellington boots or walking shoes/trainers to change into
Weather appropriate clothing e.g. Hats/scarfs/waterproof trousers

Other Expectations

- One pair of stud earrings - no other piercings are acceptable. We ask children to remove these during PE and games or cover them with a plaster to prevent them from causing injury. Children need to be able to do this independently. No other jewellery is allowed, unless agreed with school for religious reasons.
- A wrist watch can be worn however it cannot have the ability to record images, audio, access the internet or send/receive messages. Any watches with these capabilities will be treated in the same way as mobile phones.
- Mid-length or long hair must be tied up and out of the children's eyes. The following hairstyles are not considered appropriate for school: Brightly-coloured dyed hair, headwear with bold patterns or colours or excessive hair accessories.
- Make-up, false nails, nail extensions and nail varnish is not allowed and must be removed before coming to school.
- Please label items of clothing and check the labels are still readable regularly. Any unlabeled items of clothing will go in the lost property box and if it is not claimed within 6 weeks it will be recycled into second hand uniform.
