We have continued our art projects this week by finishing making our box looms and using different weaving, plaiting and knotting techniques to make different items. Next week we will be able to join all our creations together.

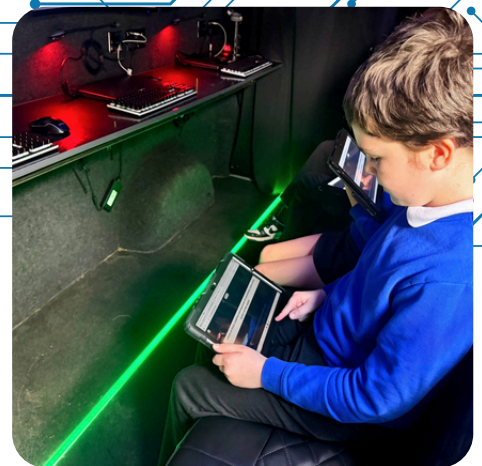
DALI
