Next week in the Sunny Side Up Breakfast Club children can enjoy a **free** delicious breakfast from around the world with themed activities.



DALI



This week we have completed some fantastic diary entries on Escape from Pompeii. We have also been really enjoying finding out about how the Romans invaded Britain.

We have also been continuing our times tables rapid recall, with fantastic focus and improvement shown by the whole class.

In science, the children really enjoyed our shadow experiment. They explored how shadows are formed and investigated how their size and position change depending on the light source. There was lots of curiosity, discussion, and excitement as the children tested their ideas and shared their observations.
