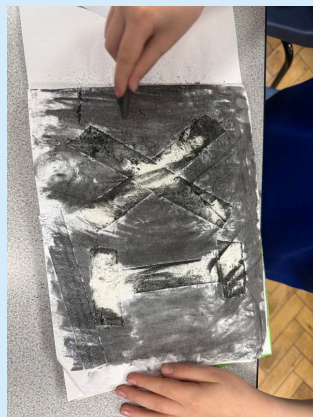
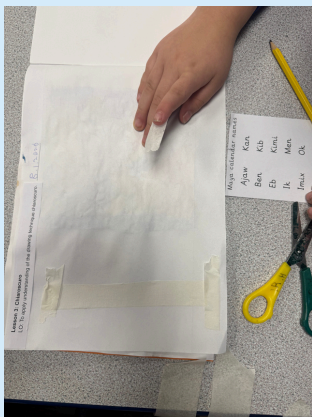
DALI
