Please remember your child's costume/trunks, swimming hat, towel and goggles if necessary.

Please ensure your child has a pair of wellies, a waterproof, warm coat and mittens/gloves in school. It is very helpful if all these items are all named. We will continue to hold playtimes on the field for as long as possible.

In particular, do not park on the yellow zig-zags outside school, across driveways and gates, or at the bottom of Heathfield rise where people need to cross the road. We would also request that parents do not park in staff parking spaces.
