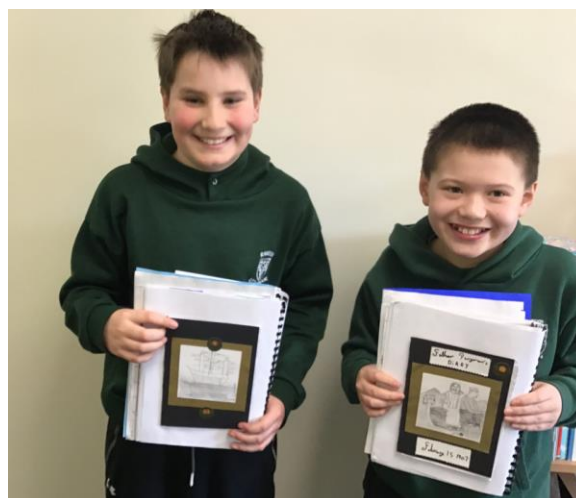
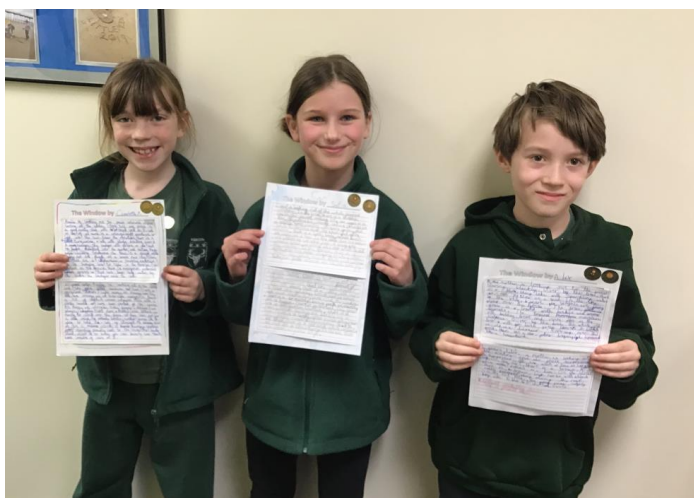
PE Days after Easter
