We have got a VERY busy week next week with TWO inter-house sporting events! Here is everything you need to know so you and your child/ren can be prepared:

Inter House Cycling – Wednesday 24th May

All our children will be taking part in cycling/scooting activities to earn points for their house team. Children should come to school in their PE kit with a water bottle and a bike or scooter as appropriate (please see table below) and a helmet. **NO HELMET NO CYCLING/SCOOTING!**

Foundation (Ducklings/Goslings) – **Bike (can have stabilisers) OR Scooter**

Key Stage 1 (Kingfisher/Robin/Dove) – **Bike OR Scooter**

Key Stage 2 (Owl/Peacock/Nightingale/Blackbird/Kestrel/Puffin) – **Bike ONLY**

Bikes/scooters should be left at the start of the school day directly outside the classroom. Children in KESTREL and PUFFIN classes should leave their bikes on the MUGA. Please make sure your child recognises their own bike/scooter and please put their name on both helmet and bike/scooter.

You can leave bikes/scooters overnight on school grounds BUT you do so at your own risk. We cannot bring bikes into our school building overnight. Unfortunately, we are unable to invite families to come and watch.

Cross Country – Friday 26th May

Our Re-Scheduled Cross Country event will take place on the afternoon of Friday 26th May. Do please join us to cheer on your child/ren as they race in their year groups. There will be 7 races the first of which will start at 1.15pm on our bottom field. Foundation will race first followed by each year group in ascending order. We cannot give you specific times for the start of each year groups race, so if you don't want to miss your child's race please get here for 1.15pm. Our races get increasingly long taking in our bottom field and then out on to the playing fields and Micklefield Park. You may find a better vantage point to cheer on your child out on the playing field than on our school site.

We could do with some volunteers to help marshall the race in the park. This is an important but simple job. You need to stand at strategic points of the race circuit and direct runners in the right direction. If you are coming along to cheer on your child, perhaps you could consider popping in to the school office beforehand to get some instruction, then don a high-vis jacket and do some marshalling whilst watching your child run!

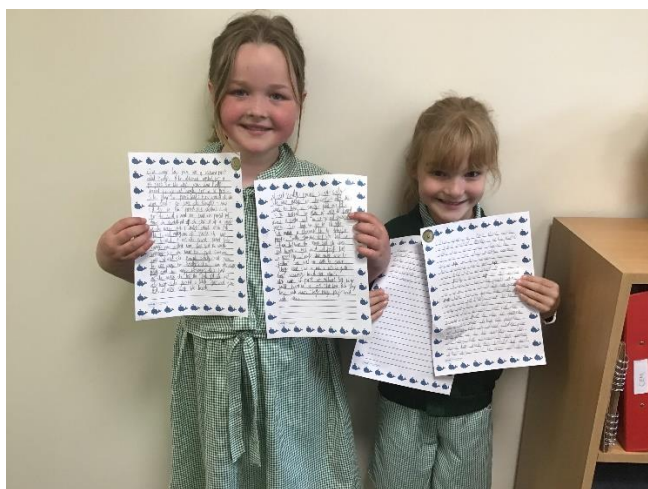
Children need to come to school in their PE kit with a water bottle and wearing trainers.
