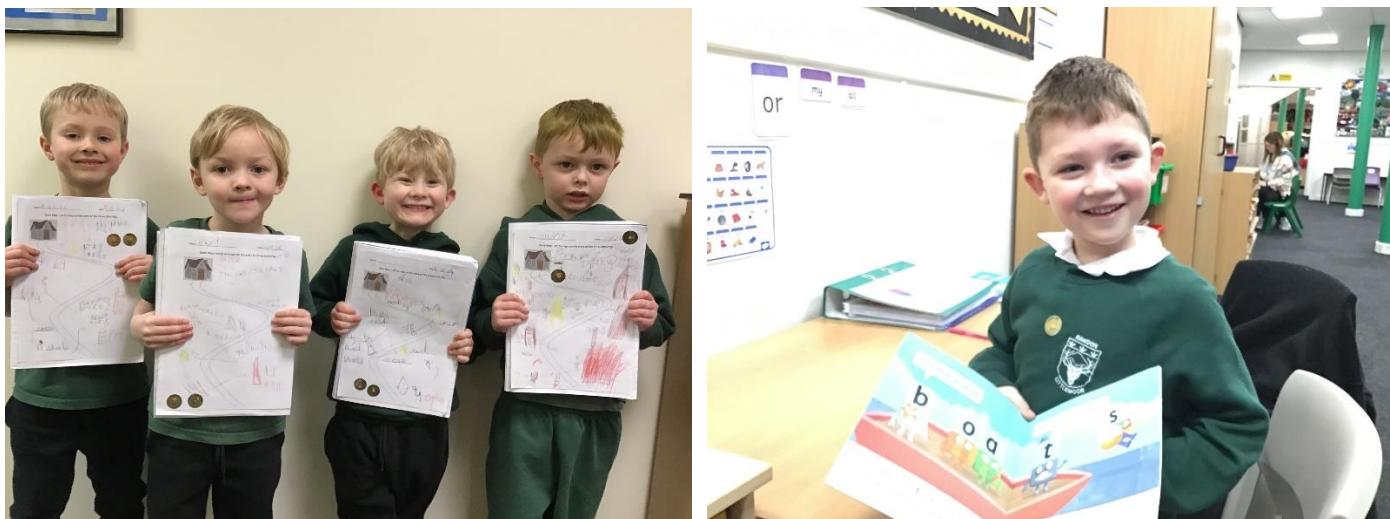
Chinese New Year

Puffin	Phoebe Durham	For always giving 100% in computing lessons and using her expertise to help others.

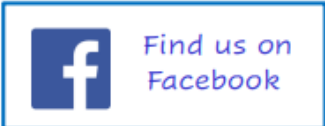
