


What you said	What we have done in response
Some parents of EYFS children wanted the timings of the day to line up more closely with the main school	Governors have started to look at timings of the day for September to see if this is possible
Some parents are not wearing masks when Leadership members are not on the gate. This has made some of our community feel unsafe.	Continued to have Leadership on the gates in the mornings and wherever possible, in the afternoons. Removing restrictions when advised to do so, whilst respecting personal choice.
Don't feel that parents/carers are always informed about what learning is taking place at school.	 Reminded parents where to find the curriculum overviews on the website Use social media to push through information about recent learning in all year groups Continue with a weekly update letter and a newsletter which, on the back, has the EYFS story of the week information. Parent's involved in running World Book Day events. Getting parents involved in supporting the 'Colour Run'.
Feel like there is not enough time to talk to the teacher face to face.	Restarting our face to face parents meetings in March 2022. Face to Face meetings/phone calls can be booked via the office or email for any time.
Two parents for children with SEND needs have asked to have more meetings with the team to discuss individual needs.	These have been contacted individually.
One parent asked for the terminology of the 'Golden threads' to be reinstated.	This language will be reintroduced to our curriculum: Our Golden threads of 'Kindness, Respectfulness and Aspiration' link to our vision (Be kind, be respectful, be the best you can be). Our silver threads (life skills) remain in place.
