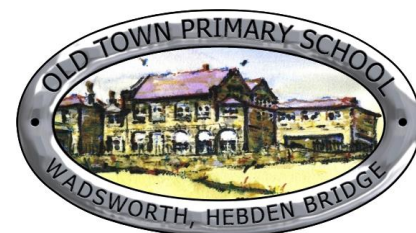

Morning Routine for Parents/Carers & Children

Please be aware that after the half term holidays, any children arriving after 9am via the main entrance will need to say goodbye to parents at the office. Staff will be available to escort pupils through school to their classrooms.

Limiting adult access to the school site during busy arrival times helps us to ensure the safety and security of all our pupils. In addition, this approach supports the development of children's independence and confidence.

Staff will be present in the office to welcome any pupils running late and to ensure that they arrive safely at their classrooms. If you feel that your child still needs you to go into class with them, please ensure you arrive early enough to do this before school starts at 9am.

Emergency Morning Closures

On occasions we may not be able to open the school in the morning due to adverse weather, boiler problems, etc. If this should happen, we will text message all parents. We will endeavour to do this by 7.30am at the latest wherever possible. We will then post a notice on the school website. If in any doubt, look at the school website. As you may be aware, Sandy Gate leading to Walker Lane and the road up towards the Hare and hounds are often not gritted or ploughed, therefore, should there be severe snow or frost, the bus routes will be safest.

Emergency Closures during the School Day

If a need to close occurs during the school day we will firstly text message all parents. The system generates

a report to advise when the message has been delivered to the phone. In the event of a failed delivery, a telephone call will be made to you too. Secondly, we will post a notice on the school website welcome page. Can I reassure you that your child will never be sent home until you or your representative has arrived to collect him/her.

Reminder Regarding PE Kit

Please can children have a change of footwear (pumps/trainers) with their PE kit. During winter, shoes are generally bigger/heavier and they are not always suitable for PE lessons.

Reminder Regarding Water Bottles and Coats

Please can we ask all parents to help their child to remember their winter coat every day. We try to play out whenever possible. This includes during rainy days and cold weather.

Also, children need a leak proof water bottle with them every day. We have a small stock of bottles available for £2.50 or new lids for 50p. Please order on the School Money Shop.
