As the end of the school year approaches, many families will be thinking about the transition to secondary school. While this can be an exciting step, it can also bring uncertainty and anxiety for some children and parents.

To support families during this period, Nip in the Bud is hosting a free live online event for parents and carers on:

Wednesday 25th June, 7.00pm-8.00pm

Parents will hear from:

- **Dr Bettina Hohnen** - Clinical Psychologist specialising in neurodiversity, parents and families
- **Alis Rocca** - Former Headteacher and Education Consultant, with a particular focus on building meaningful, supportive partnerships between schools and families
- **Samantha Wrightson** - Parent and Executive Producer at Nip in the Bud.

They will share practical advice to help parents support children through the move to secondary school, including managing worries about change, friendships, routines, independence and the additional considerations for neurodivergent children.

Families who attend will receive:

- Practical, evidence-informed advice they can apply at home
- Strategies to help children feel more confident and prepared for the move to secondary school
 - The opportunity to ask questions
- A downloadable handout summarising key tips and resources from the event
