This week, many of our Year 6 children took part in Bikeability sessions. They practised riding safely in the school playground, showing control of the bike and negotiating obstacles, then went out onto the roads to put these skills into practise.

Beat the Street Colchester

Colchester is being transformed into a giant game from 11 March until 22 April 2026. Beat the Street is a free, fun, walking, cycling and wheeling game which gets children and their families out and about in the local area, having fun and keeping healthy. The programme has been commissioned by Colchester City Council and is designed to get children and communities moving by helping people to make small changes, such as walking or cycling to school every day, to improve physical and mental health and help embed physical activity into everyday life.

Game cards and joining information will be sent home when we receive them. Game card readers called 'Beat Boxes' will be positioned around Colchester including one outside our school. Players will use contactless game cards to hover over these Beat Boxes as they travel around scoring points.
