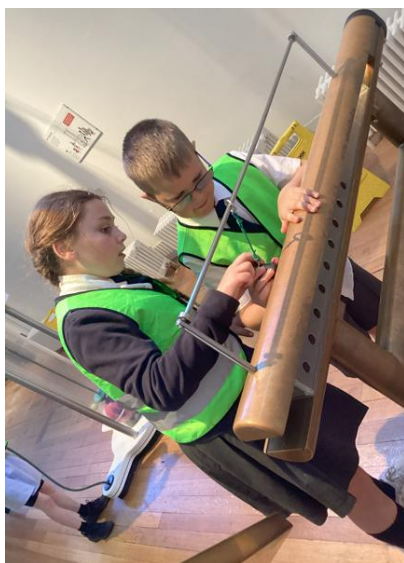

All of the children recently took part in MiniMe Mindfulness sessions. The Superpower they looked at this week was Kindness.

Sessions began with meditation and the superpower of kindness was introduced.
