Attendance

We have seen an increase in holiday requests during term time. Please can we remind you that holidays in term time will not be authorised. If the request is for over five days (10 sessions) Essex County Council may send out penalty notices. This also applies for five separate unauthorised days being taken in one term.

Regular school attendance is so important for all children. It is also important for your child to attend school on time so they do not miss any learning in the classroom. Every minute really does count!

The NHS provides clear <u>guidance</u> on when children are well enough to attend school. Most mild illnesses — such as a runny nose, sore throat, or slight cough — do not require time off school, unless a child has a temperature.

Please could parents book medical appointments outside of school hours where possible. Where this isn't possible, children should come to school before and return after, if they are well enough. Pupils can attend appointments in their school uniform.

If you need support for your child's attendance, please do not hesitate to come in to school and speak to one of us. We can all work together to make sure children attend school regularly and on time.

Poppies

We will be selling poppies in school after half term. Children will be able to bring in a donation for a poppy starting from Monday 3rd November. The donations will be collected by the Royal British legion.
