To celebrate Sir David Attenborough's 100th birthday, the children have had time in the Nature Area this week. They have been taking part in learning linked to wildlife and the environment.

The children have completed different activities.
Little Scarlet Class explored the area and looked for bugs. They enjoyed seeing the hedgehog house.
Year 1 made pictures using natural materials and Year 2 created their own



trees using natural materials.
