1. **Aims**

This policy aims to:

- Explain how to apply for a place at a school in White Woods Primary Academy Trust
- Set out the arrangements for allocating places to the pupils who apply
- Explain how to appeal against a decision not to offer your child a place

2. **Legislation and statutory requirements**

This policy is based on the following statutory guidance from the Department for Education (DfE):

- [School Admissions Code 2021](#)
- [School Admission Appeals Code](#)

We are required by our funding agreement to comply with these codes, and with the law relating to admissions as set out in the [School Standards and Framework Act 1998](#).

This policy complies with our funding agreement and articles of association.

3. **Definitions**

The **normal admissions round** is the period during which parents can apply for state-funded school places at a school's normal point of entry, using the common application form provided by their home local authority.

Looked-after children are children who, at the time of making an application to a school, are:

- In the care of a local authority, or
- Being provided with accommodation by a local authority in exercise of its social services functions

Previously looked-after children are children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they:

- Were adopted under the Adoption Act 1976 or the Adoption and Children Act 2002, or

- Became subject to a child arrangements order, or
- Became subject to a special guardianship order

This includes children who appear to have been in state care outside of England and have ceased to be in state care due to being adopted.

A child reaches **compulsory school age** on the prescribed day following their 5th birthday (or on their 5th birthday if it falls on a prescribed day). The prescribed days are 31 December, 31 March and 31 August.

4. **How to apply**

For applications in the normal admissions round, you should use the application form provided by your home local authority (regardless of which local authority the schools are in). You can use this form to express your preference for a minimum of 3 state-funded schools, in rank order.

You will receive an offer for a school place directly from your local authority.

Please note, pupils already attending one of our nurseries will not transfer automatically into reception in the attached school (or any of our other schools). A separate application must be made for a place in reception.

Please note, pupils attending one of our infant schools will not transfer automatically into one of our junior schools. A separate application must be made for a place.

5. **Normal Admissions Timeline**

Children do not automatically transfer from one phase of education to another and for all children requiring a place in reception, requiring a transfer from an infant only school to a junior school, and those transferring from primary to secondary an application must be made. This includes children already in a school based nursery who require a place in the reception class.

6. Requests for admission outside the normal age group

Parents are entitled to request a place for their child outside of their normal age group.

You should make your request in writing. You should provide information about your child and why you think they should be admitted to reception when they are 5, not year 1.

Decisions on requests for admission outside the normal age group will be made on the basis of the circumstances of each case and the best interests of the child concerned. In accordance with the School Admissions Code, this will include taking account of:

- Parents' views
- Information about the child's academic, social and emotional development
- Where relevant, their medical history and the views of a medical professional
- Whether they have previously been educated out of their normal age group
- Whether they may naturally have fallen into a lower age group if it were not for being born prematurely
- Headteachers' views

Wherever possible, requests for admission outside a child's normal age group will be processed as part of the main admissions round. They will be considered on the basis of the admission arrangements laid out in this policy, including the oversubscription criteria listed in section 6. Applications will not be treated as a lower priority if parents have made a request for a child to be admitted outside the normal age group.

Parents will always be informed of the reasons for any decision on the year group a child should be admitted to. Parents do not have a right to appeal if they are offered a place but it is not in their preferred age group.

8. Allocation of places

Children with Special Educational Needs:

A small number of children will have an Education Health Care Plan that names this school and these children will be admitted to the school if named as part of that process.

The majority of children with special educational needs will not require an Education Health Care Plan. Applications for children who have special educational needs but no Education Health Care Plan, will be considered on the basis of the Admission Authority's published admissions criteria.

For all other applications places will be allocated in the following order of priority:

Relevant Looked After Children and previously looked after children (see note (a) below).

Children who, on 15th January 2026, have a specific medical reason, confirmed by a medical practitioner, which the Trust are satisfied with, makes attendance at this school

essential. The trust requires a letter from a medical professional as supporting evidence if you are making an application on the basis of social or medical need.

Children who, on 15th January 2026, have a compelling social reason which the Admission Authority are satisfied makes attendance at this school essential. The kind of overriding social reasons which could be accepted are where there is evidence that the child's education would be seriously impaired if he or she did not attend the preferred school. The trust requires a letter from a medical professional and/or social worker as supporting evidence.

Please note: Very few cases are agreed annually on exceptional medical or social grounds.

Children who, on 15th January 2026, live in the catchment area of this school as defined by the Admissions Authority and it is expected will have an older brother or sister on the roll of this school in Years 1-6 at the start of the academic year 2025

Children who, on 15th January 2025, live in the catchment area of the school as defined by the Admissions Authority (see appendices)

Children who, on 15th January 2025, it is expected will have an older brother or sister on the roll of the preferred school in Years 1-6 at the start of the academic year 2025.

Children who, on 15th January 2025, live nearest to the school measured by a straight line on a horizontal plane, (commonly known as measurement "as the crow flies").



8. Admission numbers

9. Tie break

In the case of 2 or more applications that cannot be separated by the oversubscription criteria outlined above, we will use the distance between the school and a child's home as a tie breaker to decide between applicants. Priority will be given to children who live closest to the school.

Distance will be measured in a straight line from the child's home address to the school's front gates. A child's home address will be considered to be where they are resident for the majority of nights in a normal school week.

Where the distance between 2 or more children's homes and the school is the same, random allocation* will be used to decide between them. This process will be independently verified.

* The random allocation process will involve drawing random sealed envelopes with the name of one child per envelope.

10. Challenging behaviour

We will not refuse to admit a child on behavioural grounds in the normal admissions round or at any point in the normal year of entry. We may refuse admission in certain cases where the specific criteria listed in the School Admissions Code (paragraph 3.8) apply, i.e. where section 87 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 is engaged.

We may refuse admission for an in-year applicant for a year group that isn't the normal point of entry, only in such a case that we have good reason to believe that the child may display challenging behaviour that may adversely affect the provision we can offer. In this case, we will refer these pupils to the Fair Access Protocol. We will not refuse admission on these grounds to looked-after children, previously looked-after children and children with EHC plans listing 1 of our schools.

11. Fair Access Protocol

We participate in our local authorities' Fair Access Protocol. This helps make sure that all children, including those who are unplaced and vulnerable, or having difficulty in securing a school place in-year, get access to a school place as quickly as possible.

12. In-year admissions

You can apply for a place for your child at any time outside the normal admissions round. As is the case in the normal admissions round, all children whose EHC plans name 1 of our schools will be admitted to the school.

Likewise, if there are spaces available at the school in the year group you are applying for, your child will always be offered a place.

If there are no spaces available at the time of your application, your child's name will be added to a waiting list for the relevant year group at the school. When a space becomes available it will be filled by 1 of the pupils on the waiting list in accordance with the oversubscription criteria listed in section 6.3 of this policy. Priority will not be given to children on the basis that they have been on the waiting list the longest.

13. Appeals

If your child's application for a place at 1 of the schools in our trust is unsuccessful, you will be informed why admission was refused and given information about the process for hearing appeals. If you wish to appeal, you must set out the grounds for your appeal in writing and send it to the following address:

The board of trustees will consult on the admission arrangements at least once every 7 years, even if there have been no changes during that period.
