Assisted Suicide Friday 20 June, MPs will place their final vote on the Leadbeater assisted suicide Bill. A petition signed by a strong number of local people urging your MP to vote against the Bill will carry real weight. It's undeniable proof that many in the constituency want their MP to turn up on 20 June and vote NO to assisted suicide. Please sign the petition at the back of church as a flood of signatures from our parish and others nearby could help tip the balance and stop this dangerous Bill in its tracks or petition Worsley and Eccles MP Michael Wheeler who will decide how he votes partly based on the results of this survey.
