Nurturing hearts & minds

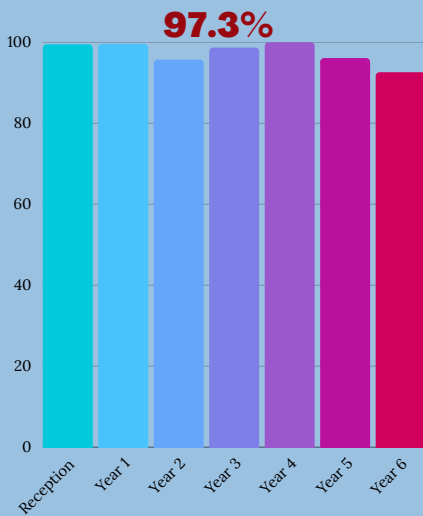

Amen.

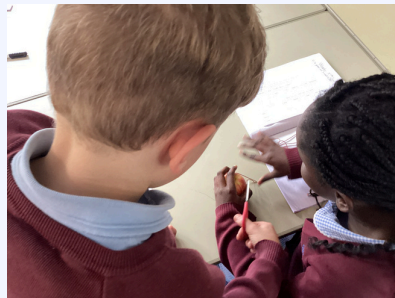
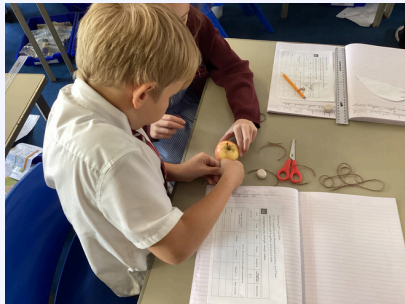
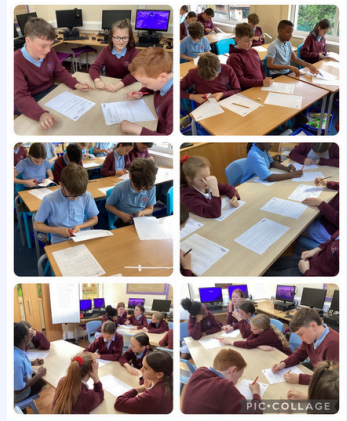
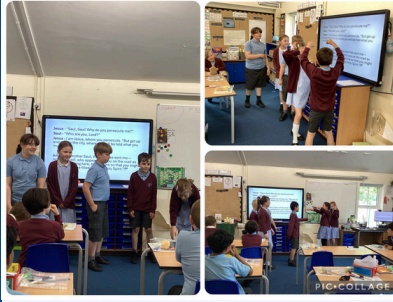
Sports news:

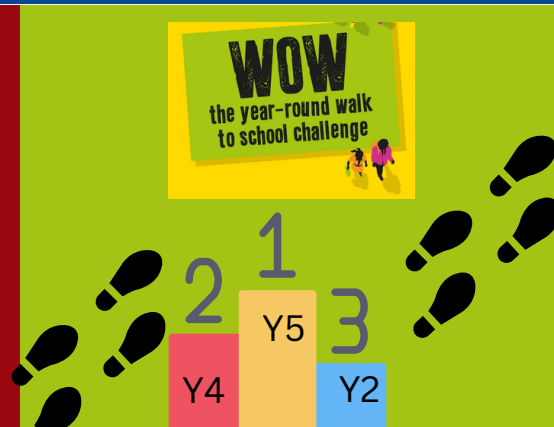
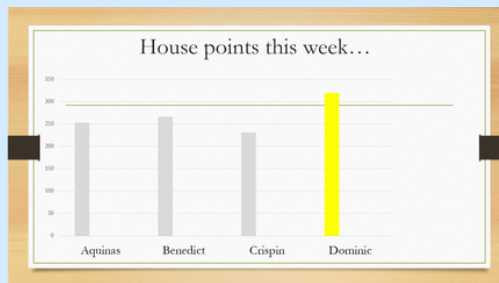
June's Online Newsletter is packed full of useful information to help your child and you as a parent online!
