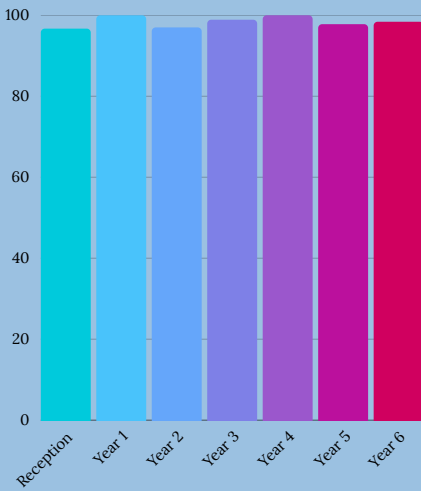
Finally, next week is SATs week for Y6 - good luck to everyone - you are in our thoughts!
