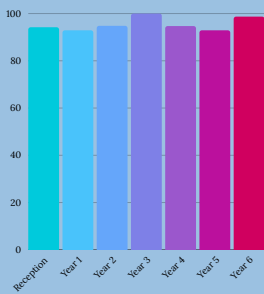

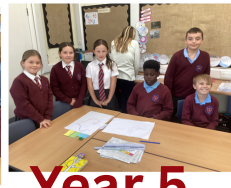

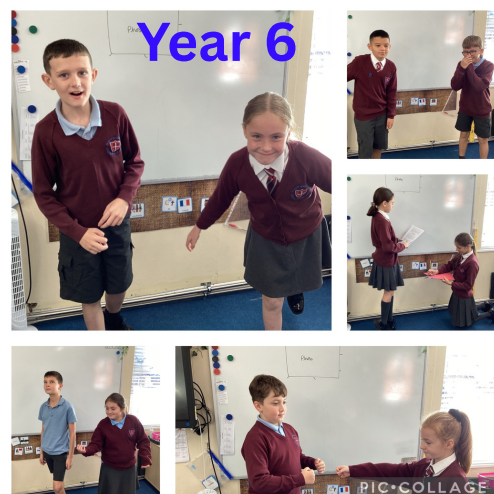
Firework Code

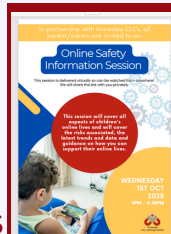

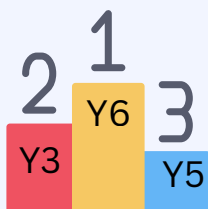

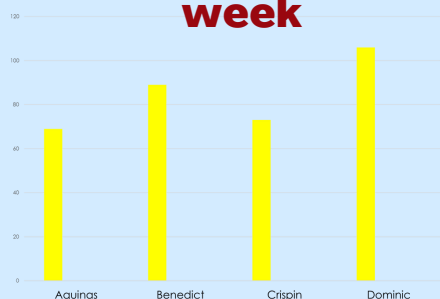
