
### Freddy Fit

We have arranged for Freddy Fit to come back into school on **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March** for workshops with Key Stage 2 children and he will be coming back into school on **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March** to work with the Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 Children (*this session is on the same day as Comic Relief*).



### World Book Day - Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March

At St Mary's, we will be marking the occasion with a **themed dress-up day**, with the theme **suggested by our Children's Reading Council**. After discussion and voting, they selected **Julia Donaldson** as this year's suggested author focus.



We also recognise that children have different interests and favourite books. While the Julia Donaldson theme is **suggested**, it is **not a requirement**. If a child feels very strongly about dressing up as a character from a different book, we would much rather see them **happy, enthusiastic and dressed up as something they love**, than not take part at all.

As is customary, the children will receive a £1 voucher in school to purchase a book.
