
Anti-Bullying Week



PE Kits (Years 1 to 6)

The Morning School Run

In the interests of safety and safeguarding, please can we ask parents and guardians to ensure that you do the following when dropping your children at school when the main gate has been closed.



- Please do **NOT** take children through the **NO ENT** gate at the side of the school. When the main gate is shut please take children to the main visitor's entrance
- Children walk around the designated walkway and not through the car park
- Children are accompanied into school
- Please note that Angels breakfast club doors open at
- Please accompany children to Angel breakfast club doors and sign them in

Driving Near School

Are you driving to school? - If so, please use the one way system around St Mary's Road to avoid congestion.

DO NOT park on the Zig Zag lines - they are there to protect the children.

DO NOT park across residents driveways.

Please be mindful of your speed and parking when driving to school. Local residents and parents have expressed their concerns.

Absence from School and Medical Appointments

Please could we request that where possible, appointments for routine dental or doctor's appointments are made after school or during holidays, as appointments made during the school day causes disruption to your child's education.

If you wish to request absence from school, a form is available from

the school website, however, as you may be aware requests for absence will only be granted in compassionate or exceptional

Food in School

Children should NEVER bring foods containing nuts into school as a snack, or as part of a packed lunch. This includes cereal bars which may have nut traces.

We have several children with a severe nut allergy, and other allergies and it is imperative that any incidents of allergic reactions are avoided.



To help reduce this risk, we also politely request that for birthdays, children only bring Haribo (or an alternative brand that is nut-trace, nut, gluten, soya and dairy free with a gelatin free option). Also, please ensure that all snacks provided are healthy.
