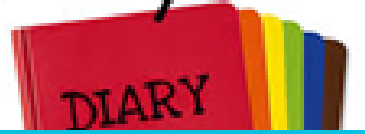
Well done 6B for excellent behaviour and Year 6A will be taking part in this wonderful workshop next week.
