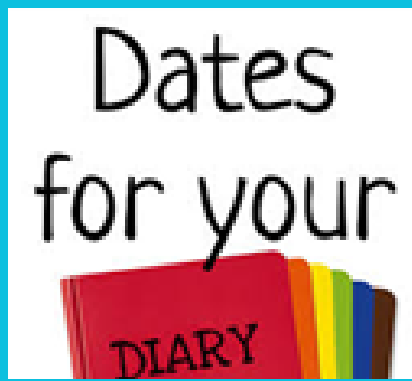
Y6A Bikeability
