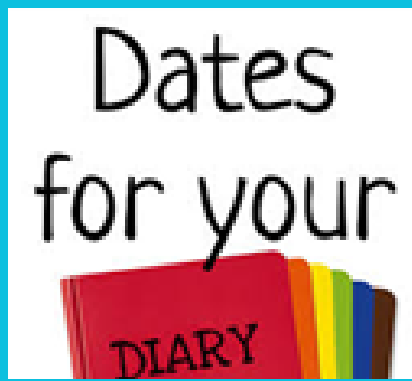
## Stay & Play Session
