Holidays and Attendance

We have a wonderful week of school left and it is important children attend every day.

Holidays will not be authorised and will likely result in a fine.

What does the law say I must do as a parent/carer? Once your child is registered at a school, you are legally responsible for making sure they attend regularly. This means your child should not have any unauthorised absence as this would constitute an offence in law.

When attendance doesn't improve after support or, when a minimum of unauthorised holiday/leave is taken, legal action can be taken. Courts can fine parents/carers up to £1,000 per child and for repeat offences the court can fine parents/carers up to £2,500 per child or impose a prison sentence of up to 3 months. In many cases, but not all, parents/carers can discharge an offence by paying a penalty notice of £160 for each parent per child, discounted to £80 if paid within 21 days. For a family of two parents/carers with 3 children that would be at least £480. Please ensure if you are considering taking your child out of school you must fill in a leave of absence request. Failure to do this could result in the absence being passed to the child absent in education team.
