

If your child attends Composition, Singing, Recorder, or Piano Club, they will be performing in the main hall. On the day of the festival, please make your way to the main school hall at 1:15pm, where you will be able to meet your child and enjoy their performance together. Once their performance has finished, you are welcome to explore the festival activities at your own pace. Please note that if your child is a member of more than one of these music clubs, they should take part in each of their scheduled performances.
