
If Eid falls on a school day, then children are allowed **one day only** off school to celebrate.

If Eid falls on a Saturday, then all children are expected in school as normal on Friday.

Many school staff will be requesting the day off to celebrate Eid. Please be advised that we may need to close the school partially if it falls on a school day. We will send a letter out as we will need to get an understanding of who will, or will not be celebrating Eid so we can plan safely.



World Book Day



Just a reminder that we will be celebrating World Book Day next Thursday 5th March. Our theme this year is aligned with the National Year of Reading theme of **Go All In** – ‘if you’re into it, read into it’ – and as such we would like the children to dress in outfits that show what they are into:
