They have also described where Kipper is using positional language. The children have also been developing their fine motor skills by using tweezers to pick up small objects. We have finished our poetry learning off this week by learning about how we can use alliteration and similes to create a new poem all about creepy crawlies. The children have continued division in maths and we have been focusing on how we can answer our fluency and problem-solving questions on this topic. We have continued to research Charles Waterton in history and have discussed what type of things he would have needed on his expeditions and how this may be different to the things our explorers would use in the present.
