

Reporting and responding to bullying

It is important to report and respond to bullying because bullying hurts!

Everyone has the right to be treated with respect. Everybody has the right to feel happy and safe. No-one deserves to be a victim of bullying. Bullies need to learn different ways of behaving.

Our school has clear and well published systems to report bullying for the whole school Community (including staff, parents/carers, children and young people) this includes those who are the victims of bullying or have witnessed bullying behaviour (bystanders).

Bullying is not tolerated on any grounds. We do not tolerate racism, homophobia or transphobia, cyber bullying.

We do not tolerate ANY form of bullying on ANY grounds at Harworth Church of England Academy. If anyone feels that they are being bullied for ANY reason they MUST IMMEDIATELY go to tell someone. They can go to an adult in school or a Peacemaker (who will then pass this on to an adult).
