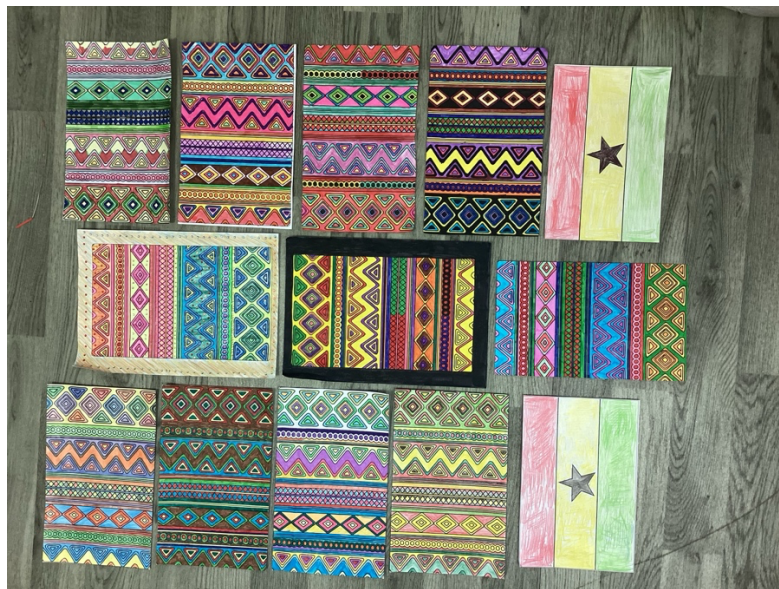




Celebrating Our Global Connection: The King's Village, Ghana
