Thank you to everyone for sending your children in for P.E. this term wearing the correct kit – we really appreciate it.

Just to remind everyone, our current expectations are that children come to school wearing plain dark tracksuit bottoms (navy, grey, or black), a white round-neck t-shirt, their school jumper (no hoodies please), and trainers (not plimsolls, please).

LEARNING AT MERIDIAN

Our curriculum theme and topics for the Autumn terms

Following everyone's author study at the beginning of the autumn terms, the children are now starting their new learning topics.

Our theme for the next few months is "Leadership and Community" and all the teachers have been working hard to plan exciting learning journeys for the following topics:

Nursery and Reception: **Superheroes!** Children will be learning about people who help us in school and the local community. They will also be learning about families, friends and what makes them special.

Year 1 and Year 2: **Kings and Queens!** Children will be learning about different Kings and Queens in history, with a key focus of a local famous historical event: The Battle of Hastings.


Year 3 and Year 4: **Ancient Egyptians!** Children will be learning about leadership and community in an ancient civilization. They will be visiting Brighton Museum to learn about the life in Ancient Egyptian and the practice of mummification!

Year 5 and Year 6: **Leaders and Pioneers!** Children will be learning about the important role leaders and pioneers have played in shaping history, locally, nationally and globally. Also thinking about what kind of leader or pioneer they might like to be.

OPAL playtimes

As the weather is starting to change, we will soon be asking children to change into their wellies and wear coats at all break times.





Children will also need a warm (and ideally waterproof) coat that they can wear in all weathers – we try wherever possible to go outside to play, even if it is raining!

ATTENDANCE AT MERIDIAN

Good attendance at school is so important so that children do not miss out on their learning. Did you know that when teachers plan their lessons, each lesson builds on the previous one?
