Reading Books and Book Bags

From next Friday your child will receive their first reading book. Over the course of the week your child will read a chosen book with an adult, linked to their phonics learning, focusing on three key aspects of reading. At home, we ask that you listen to and encourage you child, supporting their fluency and enjoyment of the book. Please add your own comments into your child's reading record when you have read at home.

To ensure smooth organisation across school, please note the following:

- All reading books must be returned on **Thursdays**
- New books will then be issued on **Fridays**
- If a reading book is not returned, a reminder letter will be sent home
- If the book has still not returned by Monday a £5 replacement cost will be issued.

Water and snacks



During the day children are provided with milk and fruit. Please provide your child with an individual water bottle - please ensure it is clearly labelled and only contains water. Additional snacks brought from home are not permitted.

Phonics!

As you are aware we have started our phonics journey and are learning new sounds at a fast pace.

The sounds we have learnt so far are:

sat pind mg ock ck eu f l r h b ff II

The tricky words we have learnt so far are:

the I is

Please practise these sounds at home. Children need to be able to:

- recognise the sounds
- hear and write the sounds in simple CVC words
- read simple CVC words using the sounds we have learnt

Example words:

sat pin sock net cup

Example captions:

a big cat a fat hen



We have very much enjoyed our first half term of P.E. lessons. Reception's P.E. day remains a **Thursday**. **Please ensure that your child comes in school PE kit on this day**.

Black or blue shorts

Children may wear their usual school jumper or cardigan over their PE top.

On colder days, children are permitted to wear plain navy or black/grey joggers/tracksuit bottoms or leggings (not jeans) instead of shorts and/or a plain navy or black/grey track suit top.
