3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time: Year A

Matthew 4:12-17

Hearing that John had been arrested, Jesus went back to Galilee, and leaving Nazareth he went and settled in Capernaum, a lakeside town n the borders of Zebulun and Naphtali.

In this way the prophecy of Isaiah was to be fulfilled:

'Land of Zebulun! Land of Naphtali! Way of the sea on the far side of Jordan, Galilee of the nations!

The people that live in darkness has seen a great light; on those who dwell in the land and shadow of death a light has dawned.'
