Although we hope we never need to use these procedures, practising them regularly helps to ensure that everyone knows exactly what to do in an emergency.

On Tuesday, we welcomed our **School Improvement Partner, Helen York**, into school for a learning walk. She commented positively on the calm atmosphere around school and was particularly impressed with the children's behaviour, positive attitudes and how engaged they were in their learning. It was lovely to receive such encouraging feedback, and we are very proud of our children and staff.

Yesterday, we finally managed to hold our **scaled-down Sports Day** after last week's postponement. Thankfully, the weather was much kinder, with cloudy skies providing perfect conditions for the children to enjoy the activities. It was wonderful to see so much enthusiasm, teamwork and encouragement throughout the day. A huge thank you to all of the families who came along to support the children and cheer them on.

Also yesterday, our **Year 6 children** took part in a **Clay Club workshop**, where they created miniature versions of themselves. Their finished models were fantastic and showcased their creativity and attention to detail.

It was lovely to see so much excitement across school as the children met their new teachers and explored their new learning environments. 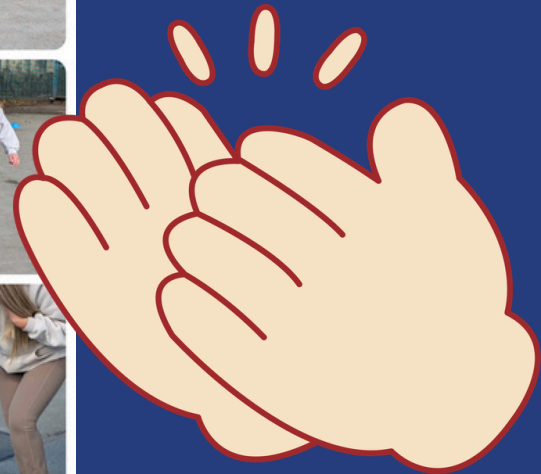
