We are also looking forward to welcoming Laura back into school next week for her dance workshops. Children should come to school in their PE kit on Thursday so they are ready to take part.

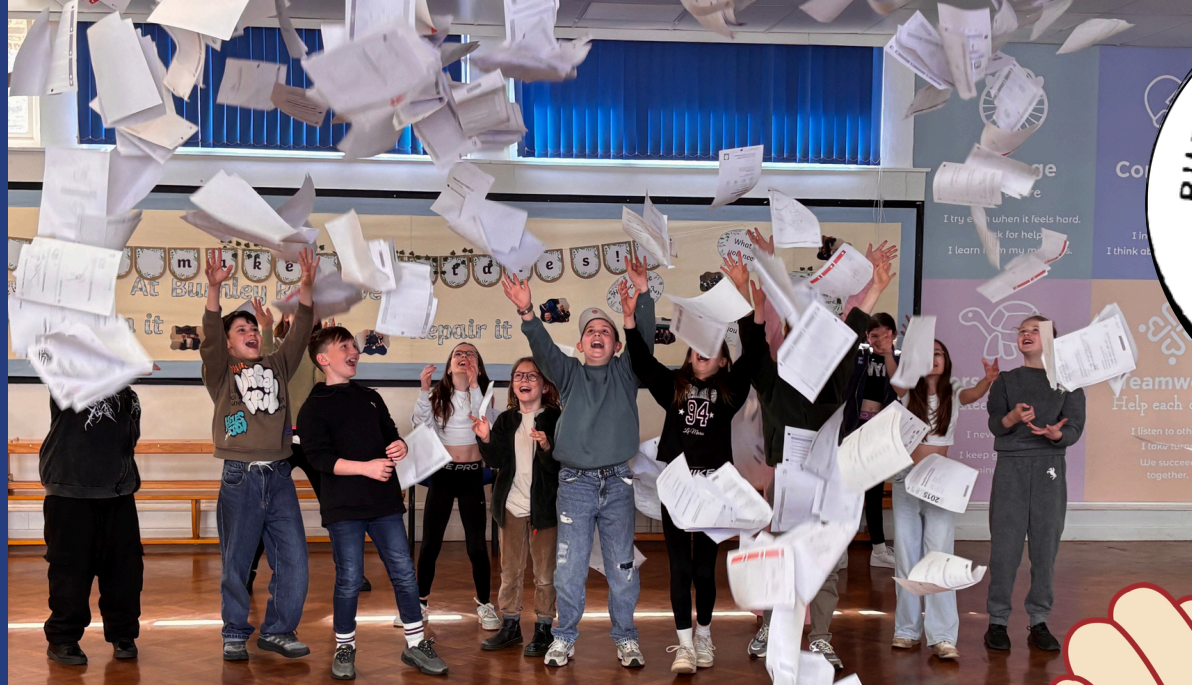
We wish all of our children and families a lovely weekend and look forward to another exciting week ahead.
