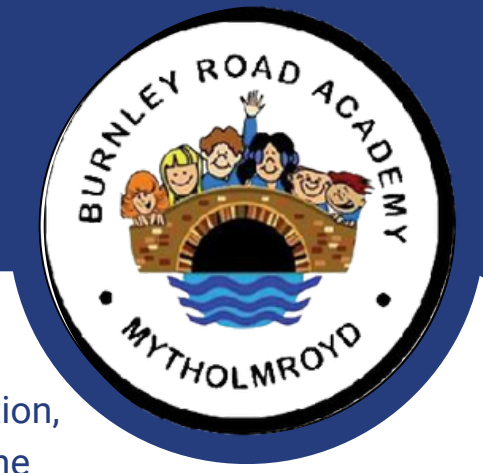


BURNLEY ROAD ACADEMY
